## Program Description:

SHARE PRP and Community Outreach Program is a day program that offers both on site and off site services to assist with daily living skills and assistance in the community. The day program provides opportunities to be involved in groups and activities that promote mental wellness and recovery. The Community Outreach provides opportunities to engage in community resources in various areas, as well as socialization in the community.

## Population Served:

Clients with serious mental persistent mental health disorders, as well as co-occurring diagnoses.

## Settings:

SHARE has several group rooms and provides a safe atmosphere for clients. Lunch is provided at no cost through a Maryland Food Grant. There are always therapists and case managers on site to assist if needed.

## Days and Hours of Service:

Monday through Friday 9am-12:15 pm

## Frequency of Services:

5 days a week with van services for those outside walking distance

## Payer sources/Fees:

Medical Assistance

## Referral Sources:

All outside referrals within Cecil County are accepted provided clients have Medical Assistance.

## Specific Services offered

Opportunities to develop and increase independent living skills  
Mental health symptom management and support  
Co-occurring disorders support (those the mental health and substance abuse issues)  
Educational and support groups  
Assistance in developing and maintaining a support network  
Assistance with entitlements and budgeting  
Counseling with your assigned therapist and PRP case manager  
Problem Solving  
Medication monitoring and assistance-help picking up prescriptions.  
Assistance in locating housing  
Hospital prevention planning  
Nutrition and health education and information from our Health Home program  
Community based services and appointments  
Job readiness through our Supported Employment Program

You will have an assigned case manager to assist you on an individual basis and will meet regularly. You and your case manager will develop a treatment plan together to develop goals you hope to achieve in becoming more independent in the community. You will be work with our team of counselors and get to know all of the staff, in addition to your own case manager.
